A research project in the humanities has been a time-honored tradition in high school and early collegiate courses throughout the past fifty years. Such a project is taught to introduce students to scholarly research in history, language, arts, and social studies. A student completing a research project is expected to use multiple sources to explore existing information available about a certain topic, which is often assigned to him. Such exploration of multiple sources is expected to yield several pages in a research report of the topic. In addition to displaying some content of each of the sources, the paper also evokes and announces the student's own thesis or main idea that ties the materials together and provides evidence of how the thesis is manifest in those materials.
